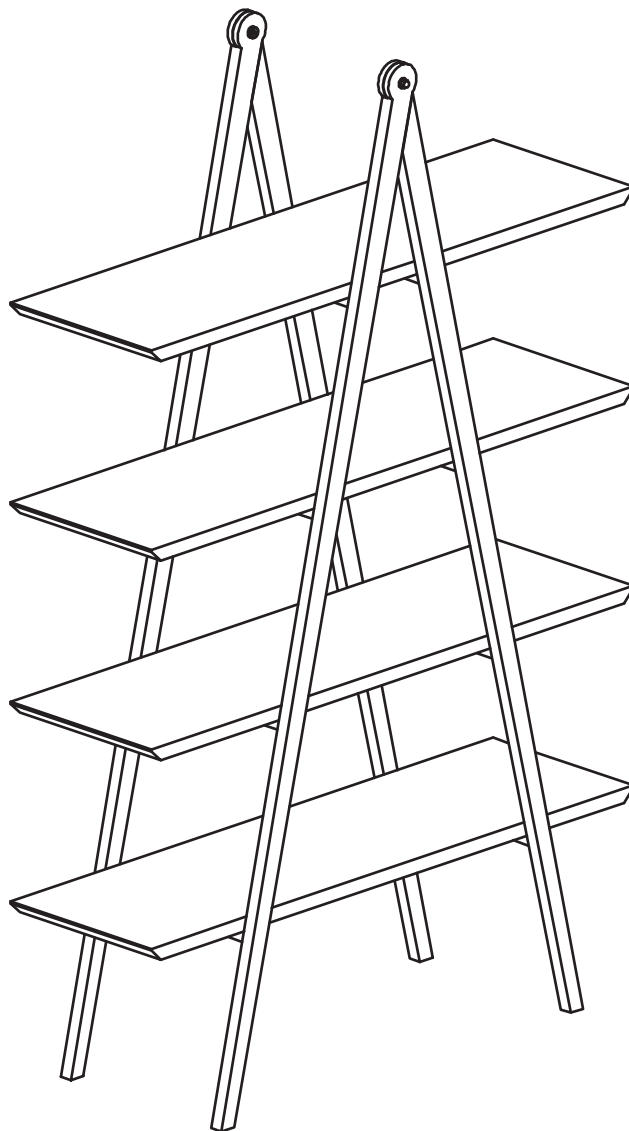

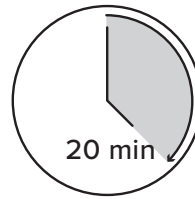

When assembling, place all parts on a soft, clean, and flat surface such as a carpet to prevent scratches.

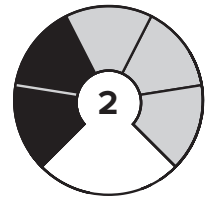

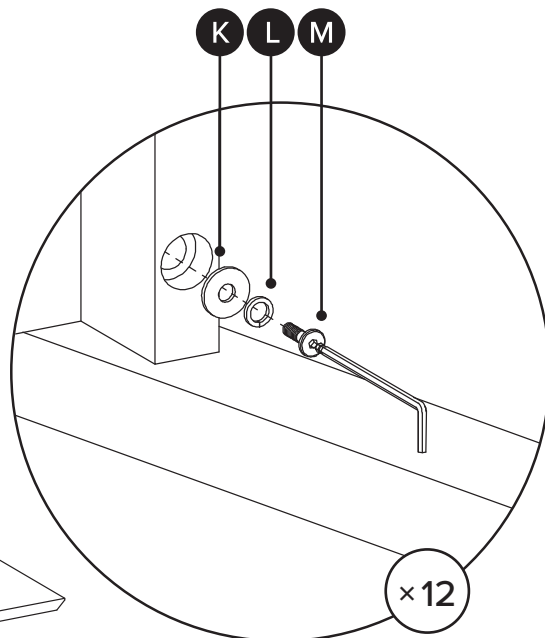
! Ensure that pre-drilled holes on shelf (E) align with frame.



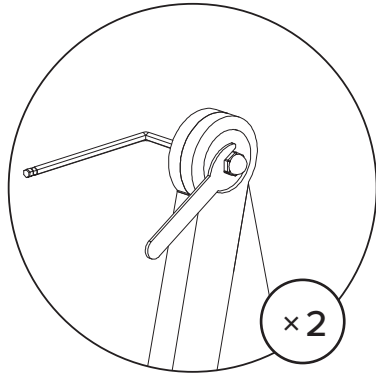

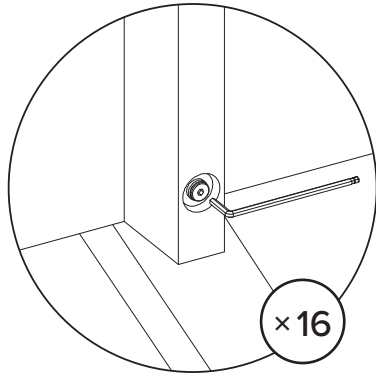
! Ensure that pre-drilled holes on each shelf align with frame.



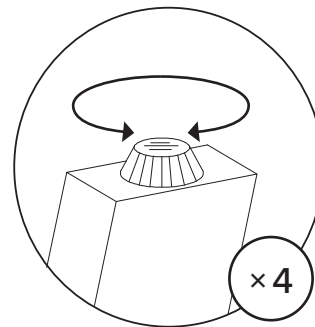
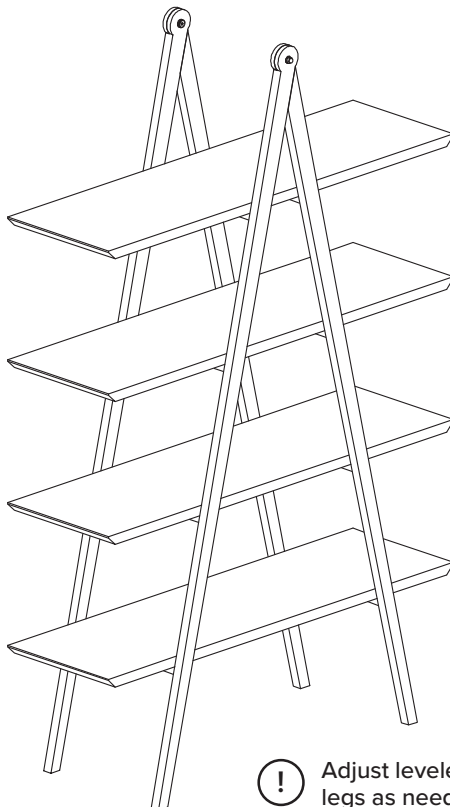

! Adjust levelers on legs as needed.



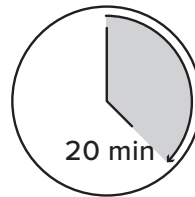
ANTI-TIP RESTRAINT INSTALLATION

WARNING!

Serious or fatal crushing injuries can occur from furniture tip-over. To help prevent tip-over:

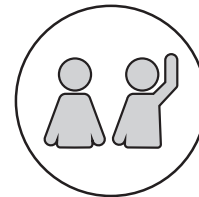
- Install tip-over restraint provided.

Use of tip-over restraints may only reduce but not eliminate, the risk of tip-over.

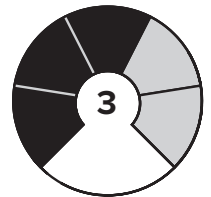

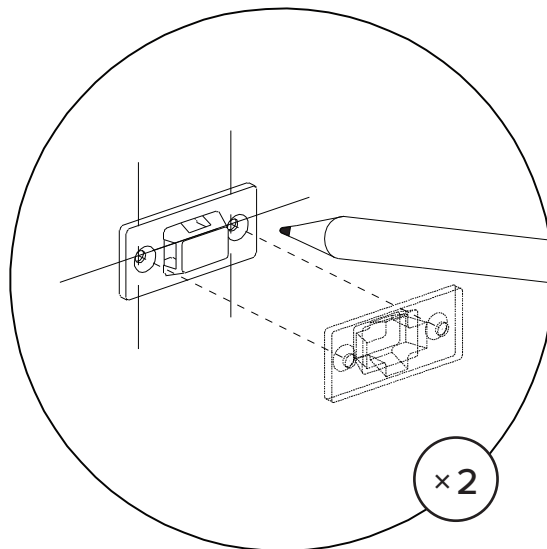
Hardware (C/D) to attach brackets to wall is designed for drywall. To attach this unit to another type of wall, consult with your local hardware store.

Attach pair of brackets to top shelf.

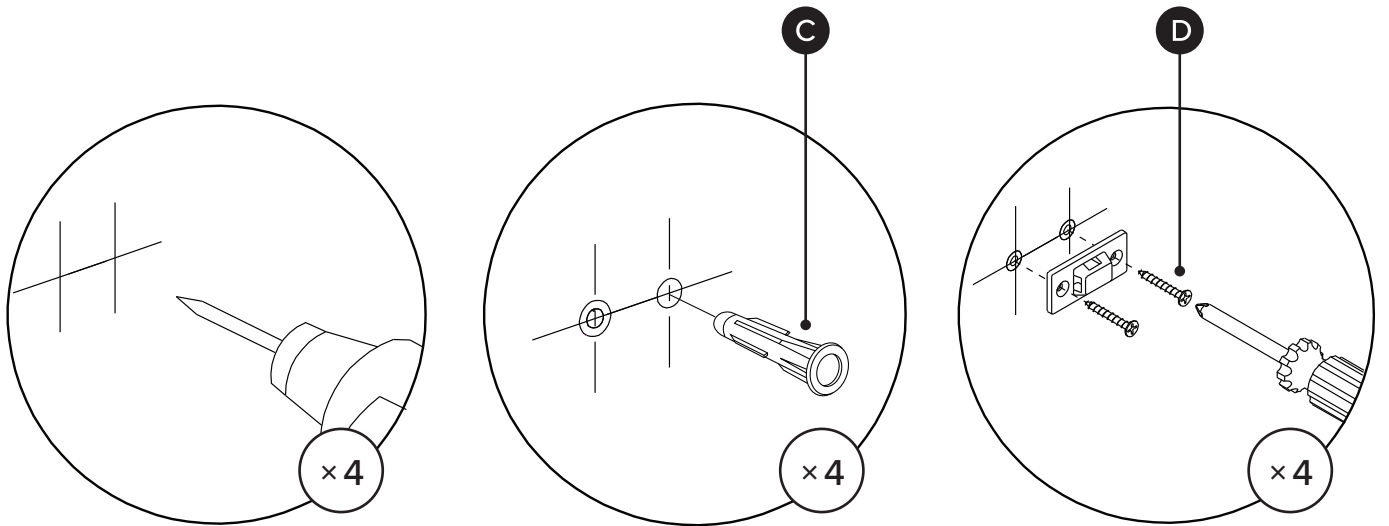

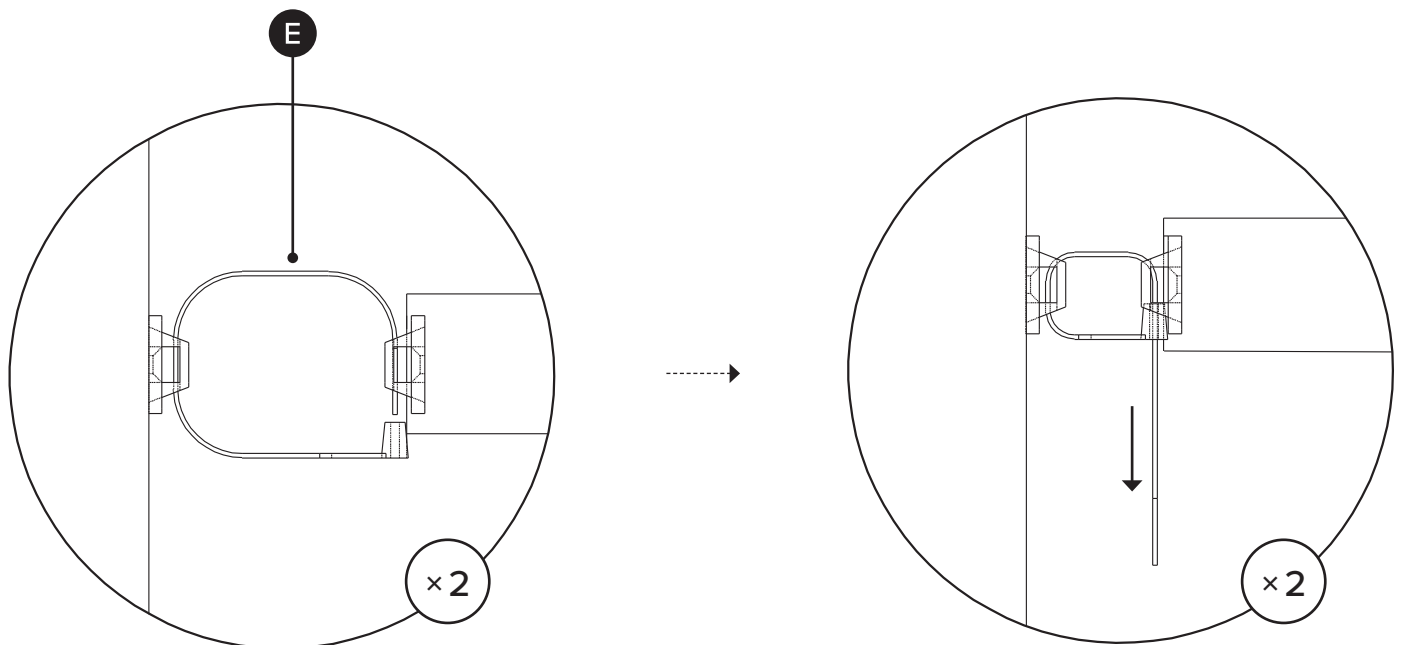


Mark on wall where second pair of brackets should be placed.
