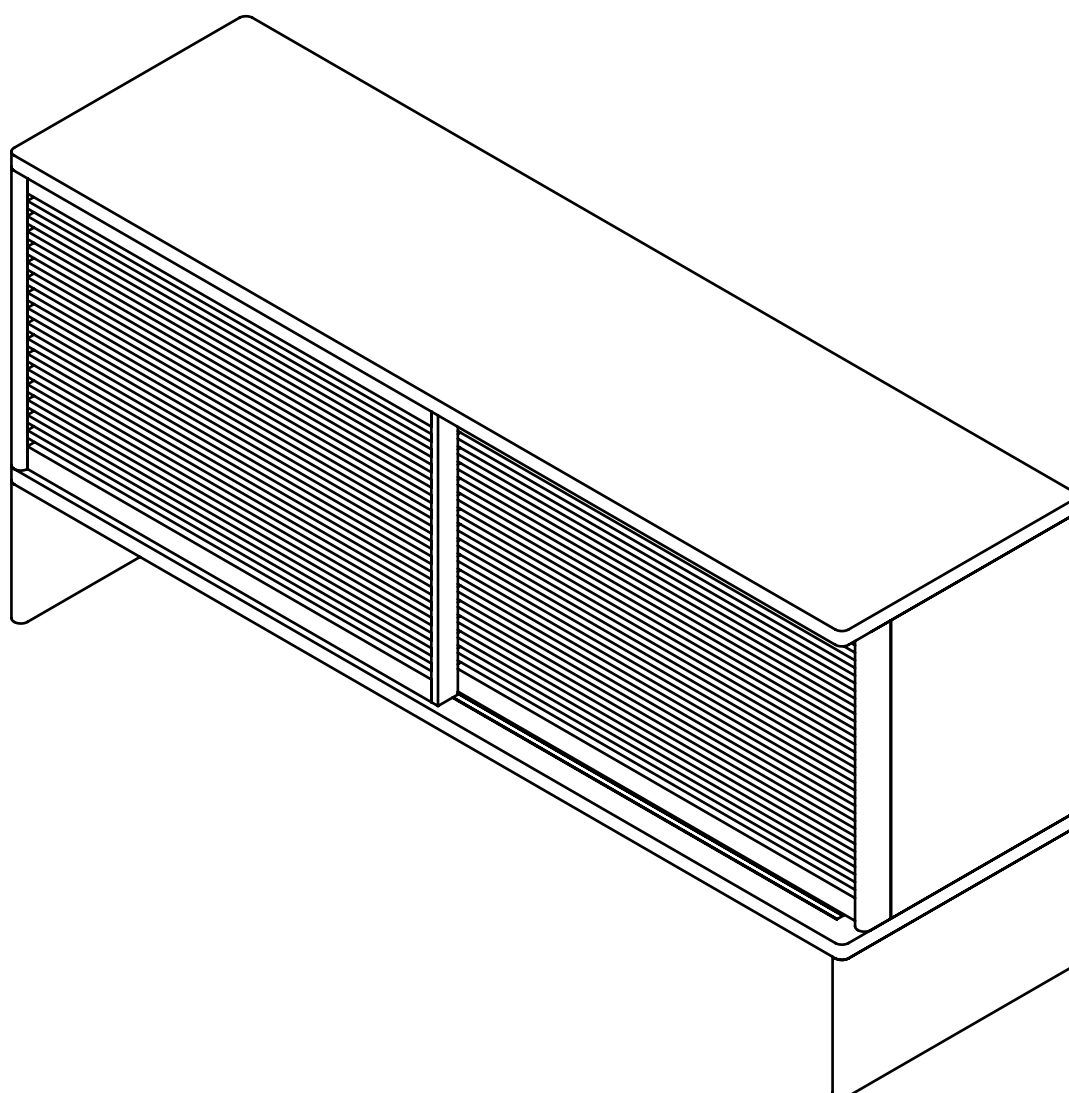

When assembling, place all parts on a soft, clean, and flat surface such as a carpet to prevent scratches.

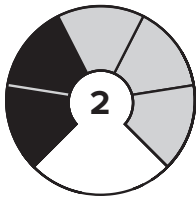

- Never allow children to climb or hang on mirrors, shelves, consoles, or cabinets with doors and/or drawers.

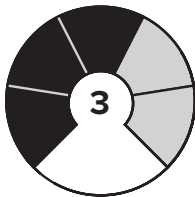
Use of tip-over restraints may only reduce but not eliminate, the risk of tip-over.



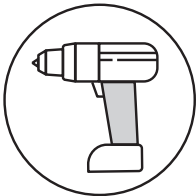

! Hardware (C/D) to attach brackets to wall is designed for drywall. To attach this unit to another type of wall, consult with your local hardware store.

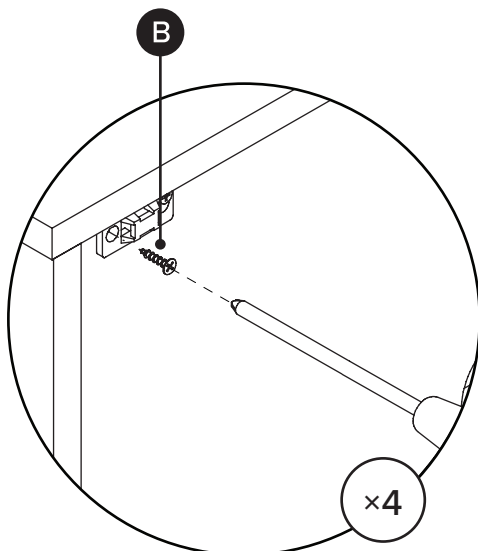

Align brackets on unit with brackets on wall.

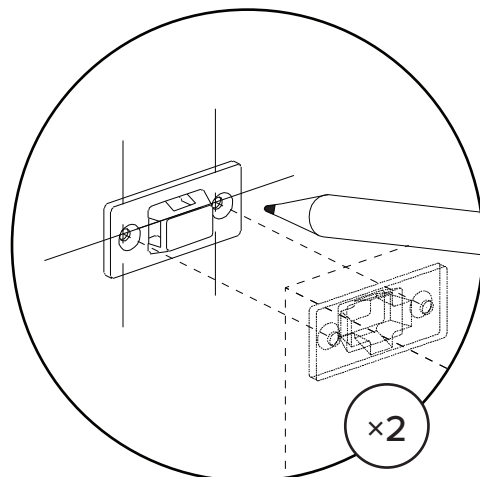

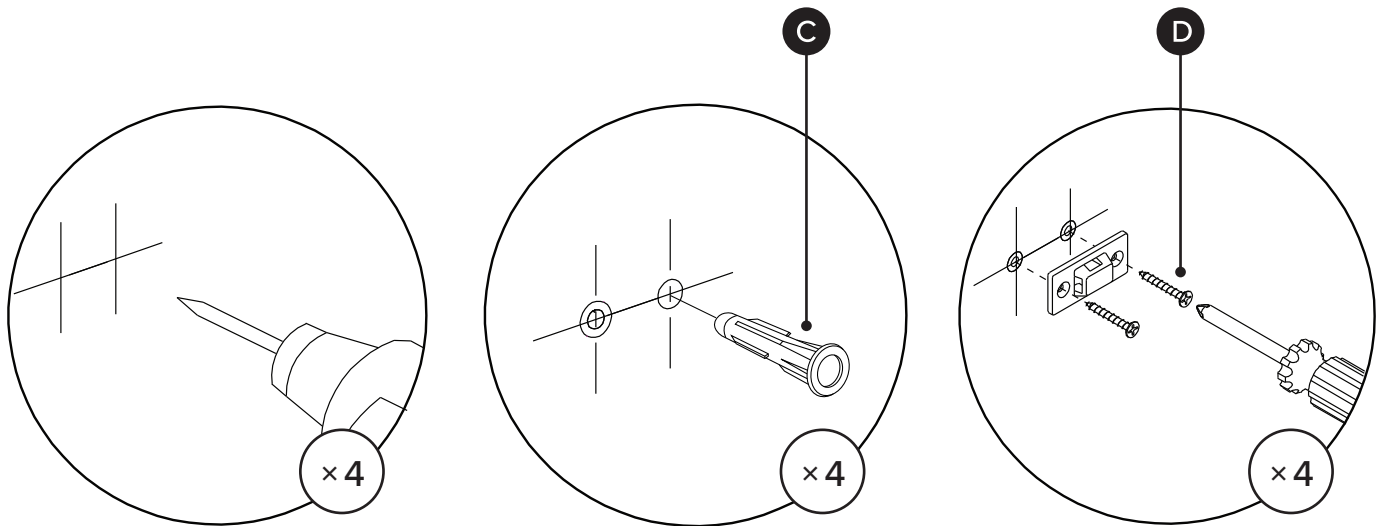
Attach pair of brackets to top corners of the back unit.

Mark on wall where second pair of brackets should be placed.

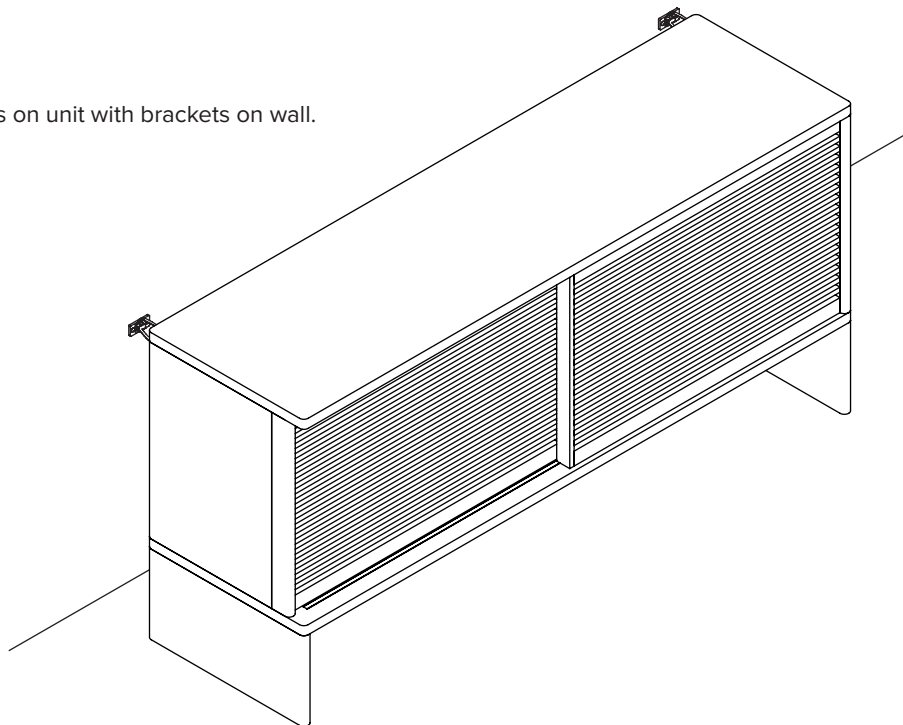

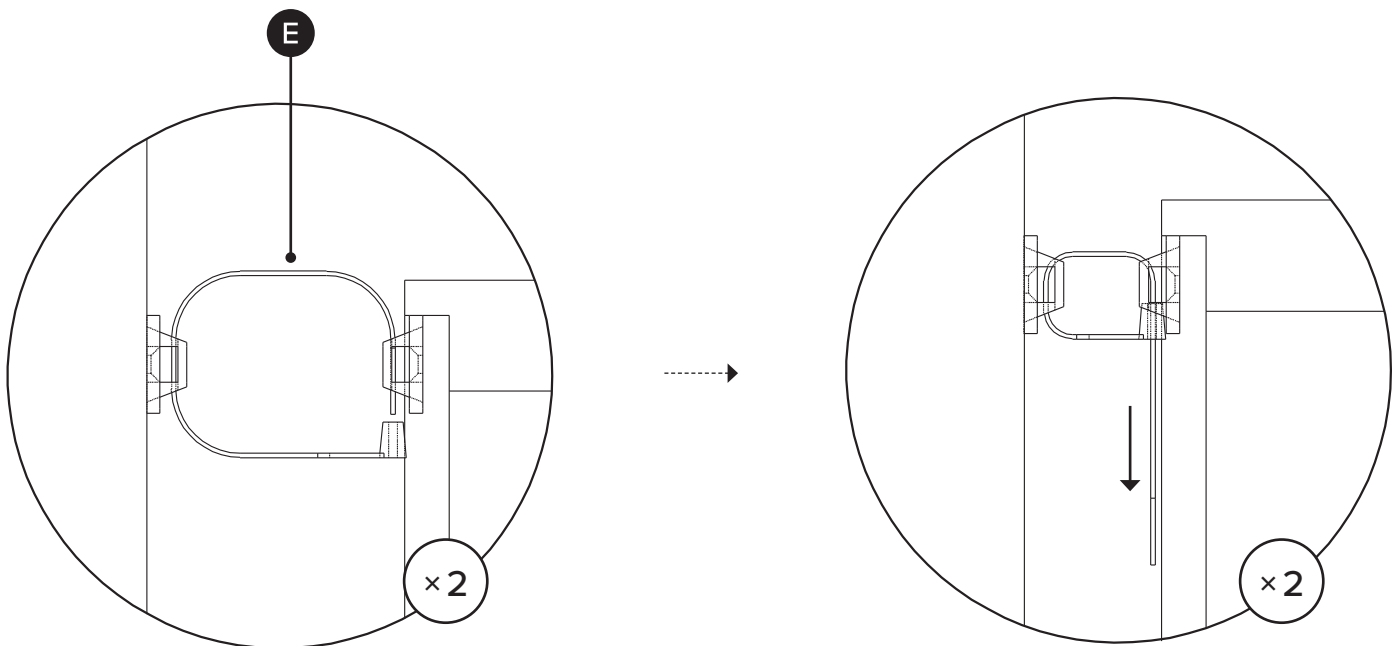
Drill holes in wall using
