Then remove the plastic cap from the legs.

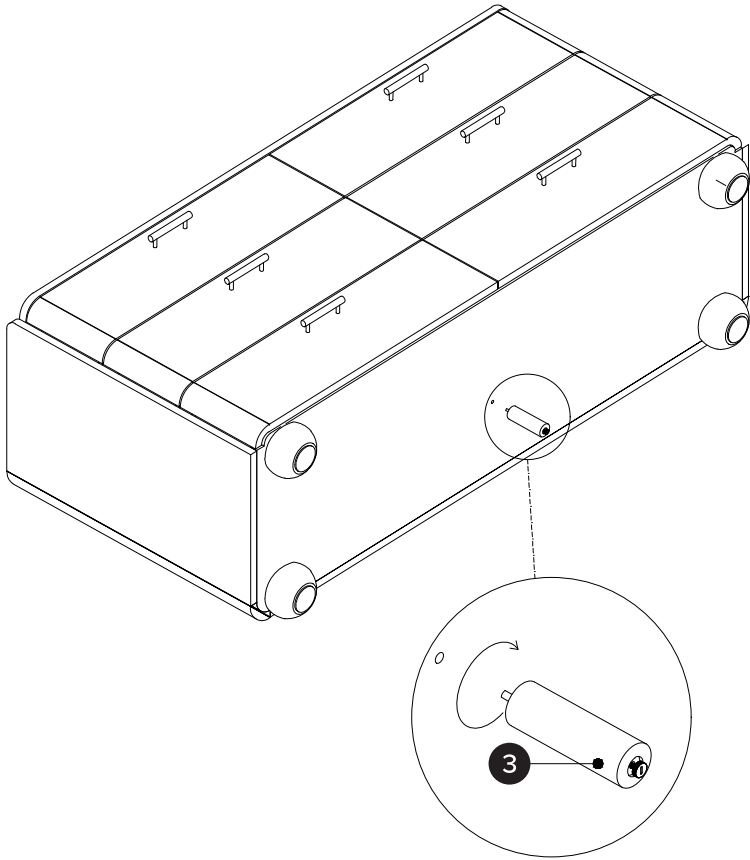

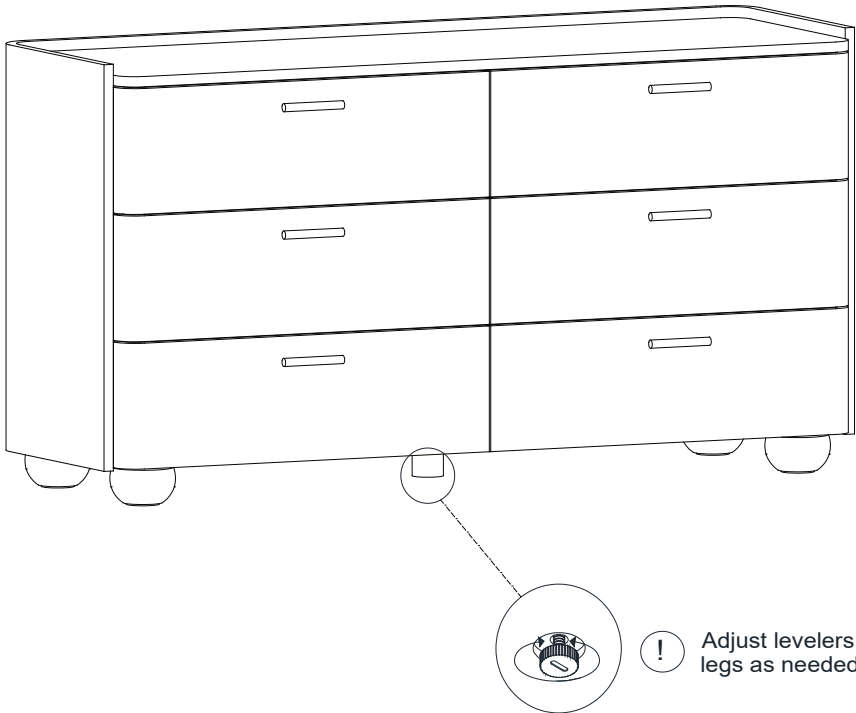

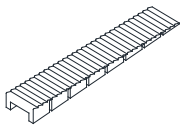
CAUTION!

- Place heaviest items in the lower drawers.



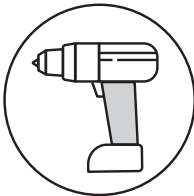

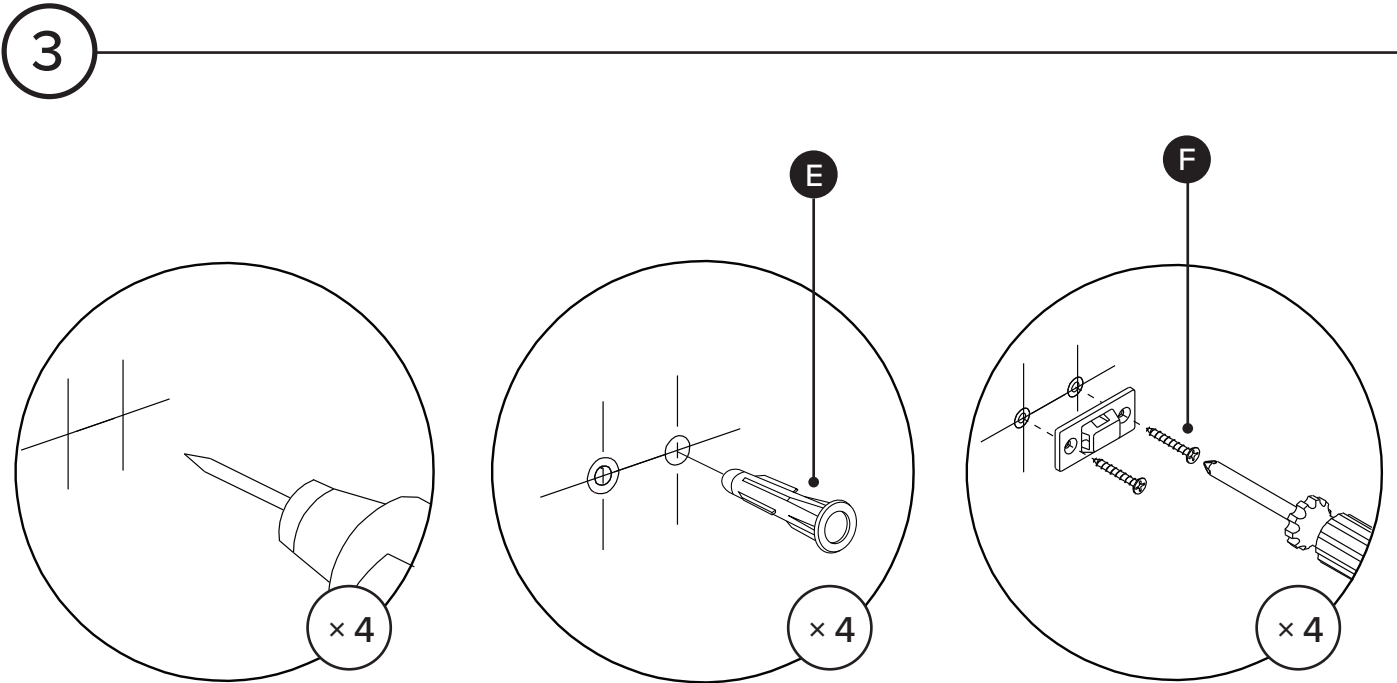
Hardware (E/F) to attach brackets to wall is designed for drywall. To attach this unit to another type of wall, consult with your local hardware store.



Attach pair of brackets to top corners of the back of the unit.



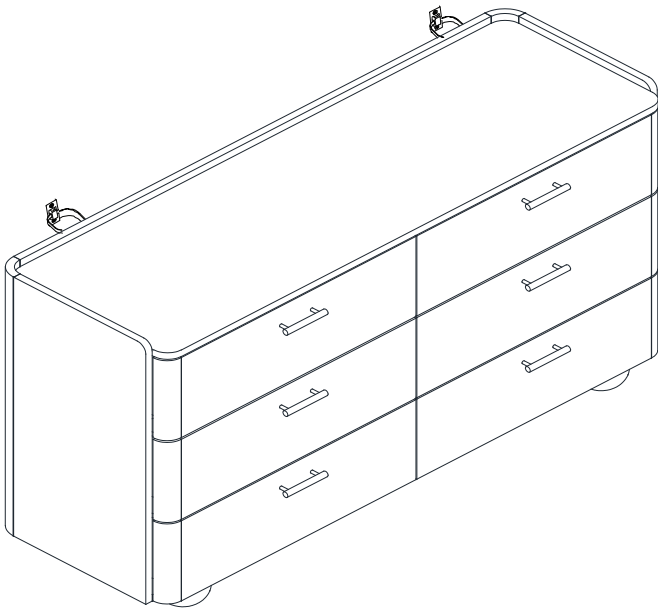
Mark on wall where second pair of brackets should be placed.



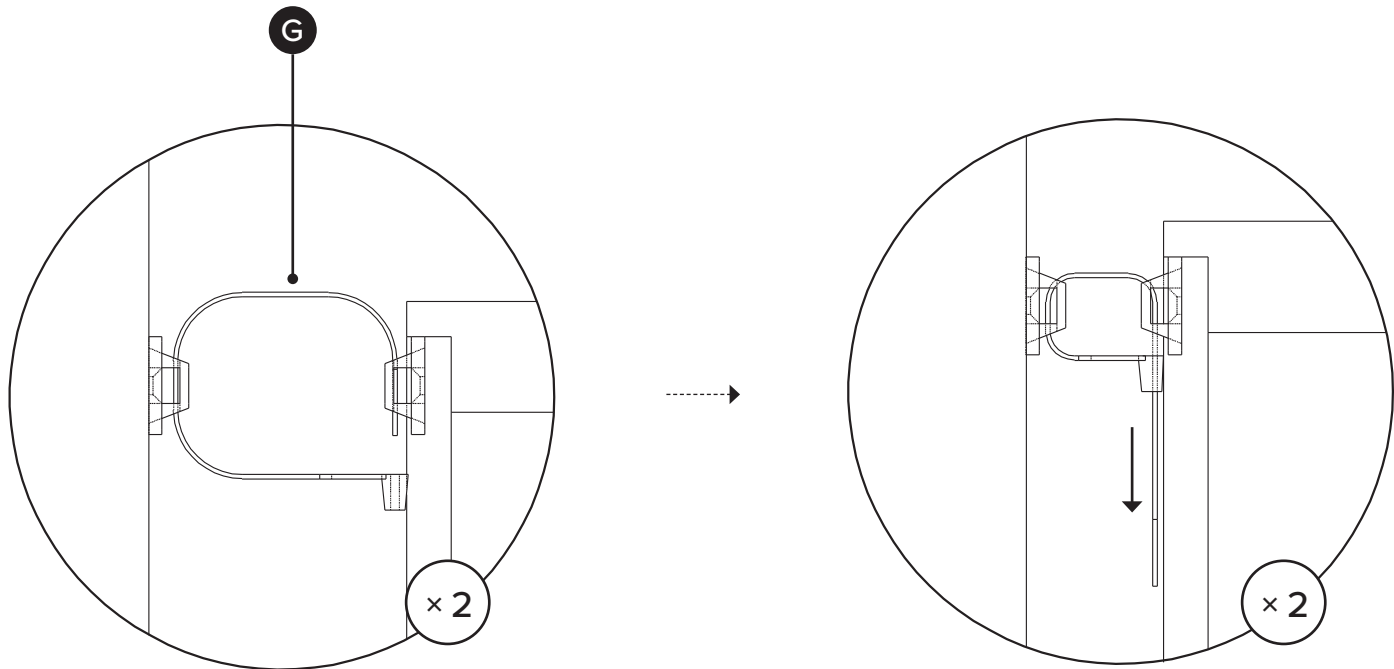
Drill holes in wall using 8mm / 5/16" drill bit.
